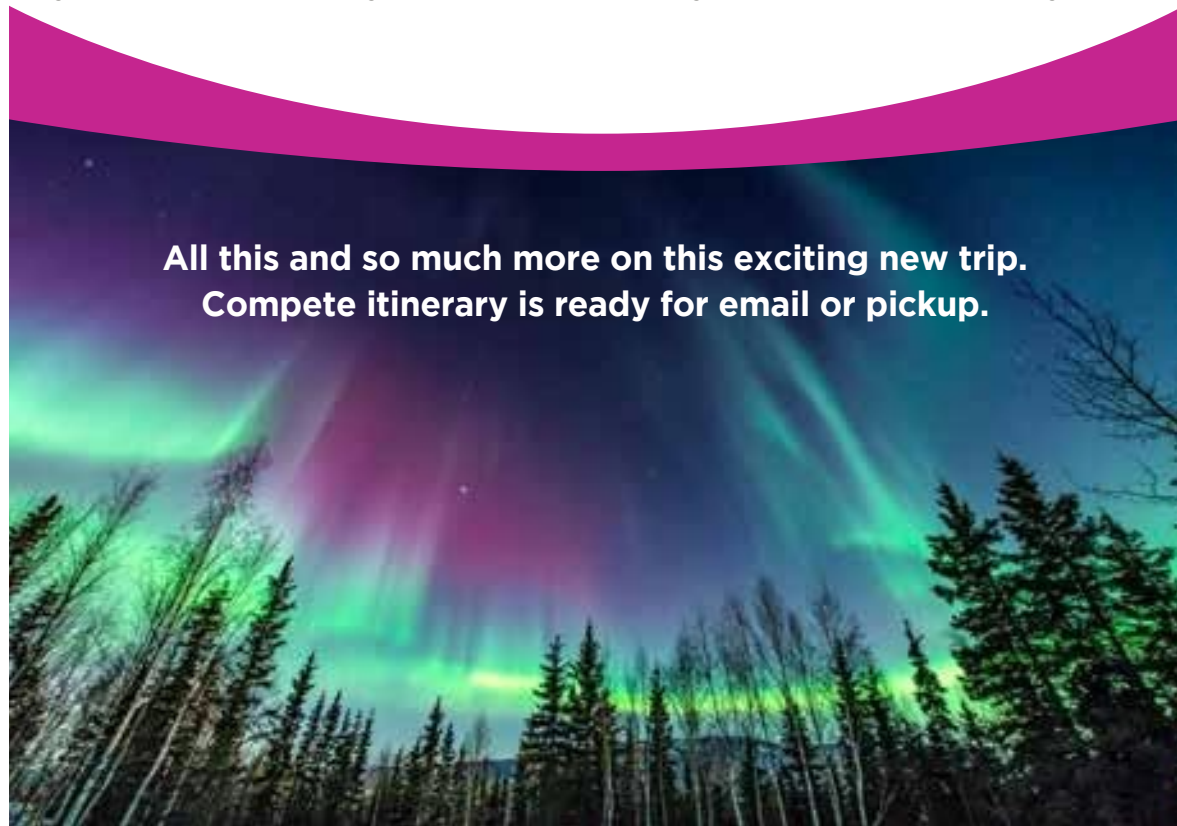
Northern Lights

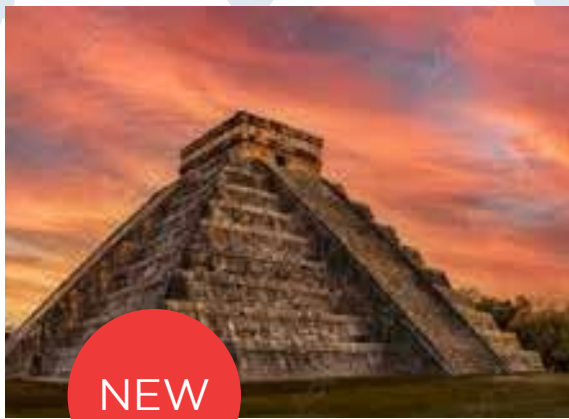
