Pete Selenke is the BSA and AML Officer at Central Bank. He has been working in the financial crimes field as a banker for more than 20 years and in banking for more than 30 years. He has had a passion to protecting our customers and helping gather information to help law enforcement since he stopped his first fraud as a teller more than 30 years ago. This passion even led him to speak before Congress last year and become a board member of the Central Missouri Stop Human Trafficking Coalition.



In 2023, nationwide fraud losses reported to the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) exceeded \$10 billion. The amount lost by consumers likely significantly exceed the reported amounts as many victims are too embarrassed to report their losses.

Here at Central Bank, we have seen victims as young as 14 and as old as 93. The top ones we see at Central Bank include Romance schemes (my fiancée, who I have never touched, need funds for their sick child or for airplane tickets to see me), pig butchering scams (random email from unknown person who has a great investment), grandparent scams (grandma, I am in a Canadian jail, don't tell my mom, wire funds now), account take over (you received an overpayment, wire the funds now or go to jail), Business email compromises (email saying to change where you are sending the payment), pigeon drop (I am with the FBI-the bank is stealing from you-take out the cash and put in a bitcoin ATM or account to "protect" it), stolen checks (that window envelop you leave out for the postman to pick up is ready to be stolen by the bad guys), family members (most frequent fraud we see). Our customers lost millions of dollars last year. They are from all walks of life. Doctors, professors, teachers, government workers, attorneys, bankers, military members, students, and retirees, all have been victims. The fraudsters are VERY smart and have a ton of ways to steal your money.

This seminar will explain the many types of fraud, share stories, give some real life examples, and explain how to protect your money and your family. It will also include red flags to look out for. There will also be some discussion on the warning signs of a potential fraud.


Northern Lights


