7 Tips to Prevent Tax Identity Fraud




You take precautions to make sure money is not stolen from your wallet and it's equally important to make sure you protect your identity. In most cases, it is actually worse for someone to steal your identity; the access they have allows them to file a false tax return using a stolen Social Security Number in order to fraudulently claim your refund. When this happens it is called: **Tax Identity Theft.**

Tax Identity theft has been the most common form of identity theft reported to the Federal Trade Commission for the past five years. We're just through the first month of the New Year, but it's already time to start thinking about your taxes. So, how do you prevent tax identity theft from occurring?

- **File early.** File your tax return as soon as you're able, giving criminals less time to use your information to file a false return. Keep these seven tips in mind:
- **Watch the wi-fi.** Make sure that when you're filing your return, you use a secure and trusted Wi-Fi network. Avoid public networks, like at the local coffee shop or McDonalds.
- **Use a secure mailbox.** If you happen to be mailing in your tax return, mail it through a reliable source like the post-office, or official postal box. Unfortunately your mailbox at home isn't the most protected and scammers have been known to search mailboxes come tax time.
- ▶ **Taxman for hire.** If you're planning to hire someone to do your taxes, make sure that they are a reliable source. Don't trust any ordinary Joe with your personal information.
- Shred it all. Once you're done with documents that contain sensitive information, be sure to SHRED them. Or, if you have documents you need to keep, be sure that they are kept in a secure location.
- **Go phish.** Phishing scams have become increasingly popular with identity thieves with the online population increasing every day. So, if you receive a suspicious email asking for your information or a population or a population increasing in the probably is.
- ▶ Watch out for your W-2'S. If you're expecting your W-2s and haven't received them and your employer indicates they've been mailed, or it looks like it has been previously opened upon delivery, contact the IRS immediately.

If you believe you're a victim of tax identity theft or if the IRS denies your tax return because one has previously been filed under your name, alert the IRS Identity Protection Specialized Unit at (800) 908-4490.

You check into Sweetwaters Serena Camp for two nights located on the ranch where you have amazing views across the plains to peaks of Mount Kenya. While here, activities include an experience with Baraka the blind Rhino, a chimpanzee visit, and walking the OI Pejeta Trail. Enjoy your next full day at OI Pejeta Conservancy with a morning and evening game drive and a variety of additional activities, including riding with the rhinos and dog tracking.

You head for Samburu National Reserve for another adventure the next morning. Enjoy the amenities of the Safari club before an evening game drive in the reserve. The next morning, you drive to Lake Nakuru National Park, the oldest national park in Kenya. Depart the next morning for Masai Mara National Reserve, which features wide open grassland, rolling hills and numerous rivers, giving it a diversity and density of wildlife that is second to none. Named from the Masai people who call this stunning corner of Kenya home, you encounter a vast array of wildlife which you will not see elsewhere. Sarova Mara Camp, tucked in the hills of the world famous Masai Mara, will be your home for the next three nights. Enjoy two full days on the reserve with game drives and a variety of other activities, including an optional early morning hot air balloon ride.



A flight takes you to Denver, Colorado, to begin your adventure. You make your way to former gold rush town, Golden, located at the foothills of the Rocky Mountains for a one-night stay and a welcome dinner with your fellow travelers.

Travel back in time the next morning as you climb aboard the narrow-gauge Georgetown Loop Railroad, considered an engineering marvel for its time. This scenic journey filled with mountain views, rushing streams and towering trees takes you to the charming town of Palisade. Highway, one of the most beautiful roads in Colorado. Upon arrival at the historic mining town of Silverton, you have free time to explore an abundance of historic buildings, shops and enjoy lunch on your own. Then it's all aboard the Durango & Silverton Scenic Railroad, as your vintage locomotive navigates the same tracks that miners, cowboys, and settlers of the Old West took over a century ago. Travel through steep mountain canyons, high desert, and lush meadows as you zig zag between the Colorado and New Mexico border.

After a great night's sleep, you travel to the incredible Mesa Verde National Park, established in 1906 to preserve the archeological heritage of the Pueblo people. It protects nearly 5,000 known archaeological sites including 600 cliff dwellings ranging in size from one room to villages of more than 150 rooms. You then return to Durango and step back into the


Old West for an entertaining evening at the Bar D Chuckwagon Supper.

The next morning another train adventure begins on the Cumbres & Toltec Scenic Railroad with a 64-mile journey via coalfired steam engines. That night you stay in Alamosa with free time for dinner on your own.

The beautiful Great Sand Dunes National Park and Preserve is on the agenda the next day. The tallest dunes in North America are the centerpiece here in a diverse landscape of grasslands, wetlands, conifers, aspen forest and more. In the afternoon you hit the rails one last time and experience one of America's most spectacular rail journeys aboard the Royal Gorge Route Railroad. Afterward you make your way to Colorado Springs to enjoy dinner before checking into the Hvatt Place Garden of the Gods.

Capping off your trip is a visit to Garden of the Gods the final day. Dramatic 300-foot red sandstone rock formations set against the backdrop of snow-capped Pikes Peak. 

THE IMPORTANCE OF CELEBRATING BIRTHDAYS

You may not get a big cake and piles of presents like you did when you were a kid, but birthdays are still worth celebrating. When it comes to financial planning, each milestone birthday brings new benefits and opportunities.



You can contribute more to vour retirement

The first financial benefit of growing older shows up on this birthday. You may contribute more to your 401(k) or other retirement plans and Individual Retirement Arrangement (IRA) with catch-up contributions. For 2024, you may make an additional \$7,500 contribution to your 401(k) and an additional \$1,000 contribution to your IRA if you have already maxed out the annual contribution limits.

You can withdrawal funds from your IRA

You can withdraw money without penalty beginning at age 59½. Just remember that income taxes may be due depending on the type of IRA. It is also an appropriate time to begin consolidating IRAs and 401(k)s from past employers. This will help you organize and manage your retirement assets, so you can more easily monitor your future retirement income.

62 You can start receiving Social Security

If you want an early retirement, you can start receiving Social Security at age 62. However, doing so can permanently reduce your monthly benefit by 30% versus waiting until your Full Retirement Age (FRA) to receive 100% of your Social Security benefits. Visit the Social Security website at ssa.gov to get personalized retirement estimates.

You can sign up for Medicare

You have seven months to enroll in Medicare - three months before you turn 65, your birthday month, and three months after you turn 65. If you miss the initial enrollment period, you may have to pay additional fees for your lifetime. When you sign up, you will get Part A automatically. If you are not on an employer health plan, you will need to sign up and pay premiums for Parts B and D. Be sure to review Medicare Supplement (Medigap) Plans and Medicare Advantage Plans for additional coverage options.

Your Full Retirement Age if you were born from 1943 to 1954; 67 if you were born after 1960

The Full Retirement Age (FRA) provides you with 100% of your Social Security benefits based on your lifetime earnings. The FRA gradually increases for those born from 1955 through 1959 until it reaches 67. For those born 1960 or later, your FRA is 67. Each month you put off taking Social Security increases your future benefit.

Your Social Security benefits stop increasing

Your eventual Social Security benefit no longer increases after your 70th birthday.

70 1/2 You can make a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)

A QCD is a direct transfer from your IRA to a qualified charity. You can donate a sum of \$100,000 to one or more charities in a calendar year. If you file taxes jointly, your spouse can also donate up to \$100,000 annually. The amount donated is excluded from taxable income and can be counted toward satisfying your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD). Beginning in 2024, the QCD limit will be indexed for inflation.

Your Required Minimum **O** Distributions (RMDs) begin

RMDs are the minimum amounts that you must withdrawal from retirement plans annually, starting with the year you turn 73. The age increased to 73 on January 1, 2023, and will increase to age 75 starting in 2033. RMDs allow the government to eventually tax your retirement funds. You may face penalties if you do not take your minimum distributions as required by the IRS.


