

Day 1 - International Travel Day

Board your overnight flight into Cape Town today.


Day 2 - Arrival in Cape Town

Welcome to South Africa! Settle in to your hotel this evening.

Day 3 - Sightseeing tour of Cape Town (B,D)

Embark on a guided tour of Cape Town, a beautiful and culturally rich city. Spend a free afternoon in Cape Town or add an excursion.

- Take a cable car ride up Table Mountain and soak in panoramic views of the city below. (weather permitting)
- See Signal Hill and the Castle of Good Hope.
- Catch glimpses of City Hall and the Houses of Parliment as you drive through the city, stopping in the colorful Malay District.
- Enter the South African Museum and stroll through the neighboring Company's Gardens.
- *On some departures, the optional excursion will be offered in the morning and the sightseeing tour will take place in the afternoon. In the event of inclement weather, the visit to Table Mountain will be moved to day 4 or 5. In the unlikely event of poor weather both days, Table Mountain will be replaced with a visit to Signal Hill.



Bustling cities and safari landscapes collide on Africa's southern tip. Cape Town offers up colorful architecture and a vibrant culture. In Soweto, learn about the country's history and apartheid struggle. Unbelievable natural scenery and vantage points dot the way from Kruger National Park to Johannesburg. Then fly to Zimbabwe where natural wonders and native cultures await.

Day 4 - Cape Peninsula (B,L)

Today, set out on a full-day excursion to the Cape Peninsula.

- Drive along the Atlantic seaboard, passing the Clifton and Camp's Bay beaches.
- Visit the Cape of Good Hope and the lighthouse at Cape Point to soak in beautiful views of where the Atlantic and Indian oceans meet.
- Head to Simon's Town for lunch, where you may see some penguins, before arriving back in Cape Town.

Day 5 - Free day in Cape Town (B)

Spend a free day in Cape Town or add an excursion.

JOHANNESBURG > 1 Night

Day 6 - Flight to Johannesburg & sightseeing tour of Soweto (B,D)

Fly to Johannesburg this morning. Once you arrive, set out on a guided sightseeing tour of the Soweto township. Sit down this evening with your group for an included dinner.

- See the soccer stadium where the 2010 FIFA World Cup Finals games was played.
- Pass Vilakazi Street, once home to both Nelson Mandela and Desmond Tutu - Both recipients of the Nobel Peace Prize.
- Enter the Hector Pieterson Museum to learn about the 1976 Soweto uprising.
- Enter the South African Museum and stroll through the neighboring Company's Gardens.

KRUGER REGION > 2 Nights

Day 7 - Transfer to the Kruger Region (B,D)

Drive through scenic landscapes en route to the Kruger region. Join your group this evening for an included dinner in the Kruger region.

TOUR PACE: On this guided tour, you will walk for at least 1 hour daily across mostly flat terrain, including dirt paths and unpaved walkways, with some hills and stairs.

Day 8 - Kruger National Park game drives (B,L)

Set out early this morning for a full day of game drives, where you'll have a chance to see the Big Five game animals: buffalo, elephants, leopards, lions and rhinos.

- Stop for free time to eat a boxed breakfast in the park.
- Head back out for another game drive.
- Sit down to enjoy an included lunch at a private Boma in Kruger National Park.

JOHANNESBURG > 1 Night

Day 9 - Johannesburg via Panorama Route (B,D)

See scenic landscapes at every turn as you head to Johannesburg along the Mpumalanga Panorama Route.

- Soak in breathtaking views at God's Window (weather permitting)
- See Bourke's Luck Potholes, a collection of natural rock formations
- Stop at the lush, green Blyde River Canyon, where you can see neighboring Mozambique on a clear day.

When you arrive in Johannesburg this evening, sit down with your group for an included dinner.

VICTORIA FALLS > 2 Nights

Day 10 - Flight to Victoria Falls, Chinotimba Township & sundowner cruise (B)

Fly to Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe and join your group for a guided sightseeing tour of Chinotimba Township.

- Visit a local village of the Nambya and Tonga people touring township-life.
- See some of the oldest houses to the taverns, the local market and churches.

*Please note: Depending on flight schedules, Chinotimba Township may be offered on day 11 after the Rose of Charity visit instead of day 19. This evening embark on a leisurely, two-hour sundowner cruise down the Zambezi River.

- Keep watch for the local wildlife, including hippos, crocodiles and elephants.
- Enjoy light appetizers and drinks as you sit back and relax while meandering down the Zambezi Sunset.

Day 11 - Sightseeing tour of Victoria Falls (B,D)

Explore Victoria Falls, the largest curtain of falling water in the world, on a guided tour.

- Take in the spectacular views of the falls from several vantage points.
- Learn about the history, flora and fauna of the area.



Fly to Johannesburg, South Africa and board your flight home.

• Day 3: Robben Island (\$65/75*)

(Afternoon, 4 hours)

Take a ferry to Robben Island, the historic symbol of apartheid and South Africa's struggle for freedom. You'll set off on a guided tour of UNESCO-recognized site led by a former political prisoner. The island's prison was in operation until 1996 and held many political prisoners, including Nelson Mandela, You'll see the jail cell where the former South African president was held for 18 years and learn more about the Nobel laureate's life and work, which helped end apartheid. After your tour, take the ferry back to the Victoria & Alfred waterfront and enjoy free time to explore the area.

*Please note - This excursion is weather-dependent. In the case of inclement weather, it will be moved to the afternoon of day 4.

• Day 5: Cape Winelands Tasting & Lunch (\$99/109*)

(Morning, with lunch, 6 hours)

Leave the city behind for a scenic drive from Cape Town through the valleys of the Cape Winelands, finally arriving in the Stellenbosch wine regino. Among the mountainous, tree-lined surroundings, get a taste for the region's finest labels including Pinotage. Continue on to the next winery estate for another wine tasting and a light lunch. Afterward, relax and soak in the vineyard scenery before returning to Cape Town.

• Day 8: Shangana Cultural Village & Dinner (\$69/79*)

(Evening, with dinner, 3 hours)

Visit traditional villages of Shangana, located midway between the Blyde River Canyon and southern Kruger National Park. Chief Isreal Ngobeni and his family host the Evening Festival, where choirs, actors and dancers gather to tell the story of the Shangana people. Dinner will follow the cultural visit.
