Tentative Itinerary

Day 1 - Durant, OK

Today you travel to Durant, OK for a night at the Hampton Inn. Dinner is on your own this evening, but the hotel offers a free shuttle service to the Chotaw Casino if you wish to try your luck at the casino.

Day 2 - Southfork Ranch - Dallas Touring (B,L,D)

After breakfast, travel to Dallas, TX where you start with a tour of the famous Southfork Ranch, known worldwide as America's most famous Ranch. A great Texas lunch is also included with your tour of the Ranch.

This afternoon, visit the Texas Book Depository's Sixth Floor Museum, chronicling the assassination and legacy of President John F. Kennedy. Examine the life, and death through artifacts, photographs, documentary films, areas where evidence was found, eyewitness accounts and interactive educational programming on both the sixth and seventh floors.

Next, stop at the John F. Kennedy Memorial. The Memorial was dedicated in June 1970, and was envisioned by architect Philip Johnson as an open tomb or cenotaph. The plain white walls appear to be free-floating, capturing the feeling of loss felt around the world following Kennedy's assassination in Dallas on November 22, 1963. Then check into the Holiday Inn Express Dallas Central for the night.

Day 3 - San Antonio - Cooking Class (B,D)

Today, travel to San Antonio, TX where on arrival, you check into the Drury Inn San Antonio Airport for a two-night stay. Tonight's dinner is in a classroom, complete with a cooking demonstration. This two-hour class includes cooking instruction where you learn to make Enchilada Verdes (chicken enchilada with tangy green tomatillo sauce) served with rice, borracho beans, handmade flour or corn tortillas and a non-alcoholic beverage. You will also be instructed on how to make two popular margaritas and receive servings of both. The event ends with a dessert of fabulous tres leches cake, and a souvenir recipe card.

Day 4 - Missions Tour - Riverwalk Cruise (B,D)

This morning begin the day with a tour of the San Antonio Missions. This guided tour will provide you an insider look at what life was like in the 18th century, and how these important religious sites have earned their status in the world.



You will also have time for lunch on your own and shopping at El Mercado. This Market Square is the largest Mexican Market in the U.S. El Mercado brings the spice of Mexico to San Antonio. There are over 235 different shops and vendors, you can do some of your best bargain hunting. Items range from glassware, leather goods, vanilla and other colorful treasures.

The afternoon features a scenic cruise along the Riverwalk. This is an unforgettable way to experience the world-famous San Antonio Riverwalk. It captures the sights, wonders and the culture of the River City.

This evening enjoy delicious Tex-Mex Cruising, known as the home of the Ultimate Fajita and the 60 oz. margarita, Cafe Ole offers multi-level seating, scenic views of the river, and quaint indoor seating, Strolling Mariachis are common accompaniments and add that extra touch, providing the perfect festive atmosphere.

Day 5 - South Padre Island (B,D)

Today, travel to South Padre Island, 34 miles of beautiful white sand and clear emerald waters. South Padre Island is one of the world's most exquisite barrier islands. Stop by the Visitors Center for a warm welcome before hotel check-in.

Check into the Holiday Inn Express for a three-night stay. It's just a three-minute walk to the beach where you can enjoy the array of available adventures.

Day 6 - Free Time - Dolphin Cruise (B)

After breakfast, enjoy free time this morning and afternoon to explore the island on your own. Experience tranquil views of the Gulf of Mexico, and the soft, sandy beaches of South Texas all from your hotel.

At sunset, enjoy an evening Dolphin Cruise. South Texas is a year-round home to several large pods of dolphins. Share the thrill of meeting bottle-nose and spinner dolphins in the wild and experience the unique bond and kinship they inspire in mankind. Take in sunshine and salt air along with an educational presentation aboard the 60' cruise boat Double Sunshine. Following your cruise, dinner is on your own this evening.

Day 7 - Birding & Sea Turtles (B)

This morning after breakfast, visit the South Padre Island Birding and Nature Center. It is the Rio Grande Valley's premier destination for birdwatching. The unique location is the perfect place to observe the birds, butterflies and natural wildlife in coastal South Texas. Your naturalist will take you on an informative walk at the bay-front boardwalks with extra time to explore the nature center, a five-story tower with spectacular views of Laguna Madre, beaches and dunes of South Padre Island, the Gulf of Mexico, and the island skyline. You will also have time to visit the newly added Alligator Sanctuary for rescued and nuisance alligators.

Next, visit the world-renowned Sea Turtle Inc. Founded in 1977 by Ila Loetscher, better known as 'The Turtle Lady," the organization has dedicated itself to the rescue, rehabilitation and release of sea turtles. Sea Turtle Inc. is instrumental in bringing back the Kemp's Ridley sea turtle from the brink of extinction. The remainder of your afternoon and evening are free on South Padre Island. Dinner is on your own.

Day 8 - King Ranch Tour - Waco, TX (B,L,D)

Departing South Padre Island this morning, you visit the largest ranch in Texas. The King Ranch comprises 825,000 acres and was founded in 1853 by Captain Richard King and Gideon K. Lewis. The journey begins at the historic Santa Gertrudis Creek where Captain King first camped in 1852. Your guide will explain the history and the modern day workings of the Ranch. A BBQ lunch in the Cowboy Camphouse is also included with your visit to the Ranch.





Continue travel to Waco, TX for a night at the Comfort Suites. Enjoy dinner at a local Waco restaurant near your hotel.

Day 9 - Magnolia Market - Claremore, OK/ Will Rogers (B,D)

The morning is yours to enjoy at Magnolia Market at the Silos owned by Chip & Joanna Gaines, hosts of HGTV's "Fixer Upper." Start with lunch on your own at the 'Siloteria' - a collection of food trucks located there. Then you have time for shopping in the Market, games on the lawn, and touring the garden. The Market itself is staged and setup with one goal in mind: to inspire you to own the space you're in.

This afternoon you depart Waco for Claremore, OK and a night at the Hampton Inn. Tonight, enjoy dinner at the Hammett House where you will be greeted by the storyteller Will Rogers.

Day 10 - Depart (B)

After breakfast this morning you depart for home.
