Virginia Beach - "Rockin' the Boardwalk"

9 Days October 11-19, 2020

Day 1 – Louisville, KY – Board your motorcoach this morning and travel to Louisville, KY. On arrival, check into the Hampton Inn & Suites, Louisville East for the night. Tonight, you head to the Evan Williams Bourbon Experience. It is an artisanal distillery located in downtown Louisville on Whiskey row and celebrates the legacy of Evan Williams, Kentucky's first distiller. While here dinner is included in their Speakeasy. Also included is a Mixologist demonstrates how to make a mint julep. (D)

Day 2 - Beckley, WV – Tamarack – One Woman Show - Today travel to Beckley, WV for a night at the Country Inn & Suites. You have a voucher for dinner this evening at the Tamarack Food Court. Enjoy delectable Appalachian inspired cuisine prepared by Tamarack chefs. You will also have time to shop amongst all the West Virginia made products.

Tonight, you enjoy the one-woman show "Coal Camp Memories." It is a poignant, occasionally humorous, but realistic look at a girl's life in the Coal Camps. The scenes represent events from her life at the ages of 6, 16, 26 and then a reflection on her life from the age 60. (B,D)

Day 3 – Virginia Beach, VA - Beach Boys - After breakfast, travel to Virginia Beach, VA for three nights on the oceanfront. Tonight's big event is the Beach Boys Boardwalk Bash. Please come in colorful shirts and dresses, flip flops, sun glasses, beach hats, get in the mood – enjoy the food – a plated Beach Bum dinner, a healthy meal with a chicken dish, vegetables and delicious dessert. This is a themed party, a California blend of dinner and dancing that starts the night right.

After dinner there is a large dance floor and a great tribute band by the name of Still Surfin' playing the Best of the Beach Boys. You'll be feeling those "Good, good, good vibrations" as you listen to such classics as "California Girls," "Surfer Girl," "Little Deuce Coupe," and "I Get Around." For many people this is a night of youthful nostalgia, memories of Beach Movies and Sock Hops. For others it's a chance to hear the musical harmonies of another generation. It's a night with a show band, a dance floor and a creative menu. What's not to like? (B,D)

Day 4 - Lunch & Tour at VA Beach Military Aviation Museum – Concert by The Sounds of the Supremes – Today's feature is Luncheon & Tour at VA Beach Military Aviation Museum. They have a wonderful collection of Military Aircraft from the beginning of aviation history until today. The lunch includes a musical tribute to Frank Sinatra and a flyover by an historic airplane. It's a great day that ends with dinner on own.

Tonight, enjoy a concert by "The Sounds Of the Supremes™," a group preserving the music of 'The Supremes.' Since the late 1980's lead singer Kaaren Ragland and this group have achieved remarkable worldwide success. Joined by Kathy Merrick and Althea Burkhalter, these three American women possess a wealth of experience in recording, television, cabaret, theater and musicals, and deliver a fantastic vocal blend on Motown classics, standards, contemporary songs blended with stylish choreography and unrivaled glamour. This music has shown itself to be one of the most definitive and enduring contributions to American Pop music history and it will have you dancing in the aisles, swinging and swaying to the beat. Day 5 - Spirit of Norfolk Luncheon Cruise – Evening with the Jersey Boys – Start the day with a Spirit of Norfolk Luncheon Cruise. Their freshly prepared onboard buffet-style is a sampling of flavors and will satisfy all tastes. The cruise departs downtown Norfolk and offers great views along the Elizabeth River Waterfront, including the location of the first battle between ironclad ships: The Monitor & Merimac, plus the Norfolk Naval Base home port for the Atlantic Fleet and its 125 vessels including nuclear submarines and aircraft carriers.

This evening, enjoy a great Italian dinner followed by another marvelous music show by "Let's Hang On!" Performing to Sold-Out audiences nationwide, this is a full-blown 10 person stage show featuring a Live Band, who preserve the music and style of the iconic 60's group, "Frankie Valli and The Four Seasons."

Playing all the classic "Seasons" songs, they capture that vocal virtuosity, the tight harmonies, and crisp choreography that made The Four Seasons one of the greatest vocal groups of all time. Songs include mega hits like: "Sherry," "Big Girls Don't Cry," "Walk Like A Man," "Can't Take My Eyes Off Of You," and many more mega hits of the 60's. Voted America's #1 Frankie Valli Tribute Show! "Let's Hang On!" will make you want to get out of your seat and dance the night away. (B,L,D)

Day 6 - National Museum of the U.S. Army – Alexandria, VA – Depart Virginia Beach this morning stop in Fort Belvoir, VA at the National Museum of the United States Army. The National Army Museum celebrates the selfless service and sacrifice of over 30 million men and women who have worn the Army uniform since 1775. As the Army's national landmark, the Museum honors United States Soldiers – past, present, and future – and provide an interactive educational experience explaining the Army's role in creating and defending our nation, as well as the Army's social initiatives and contributions for more than 240 years.

Then you arrive in Alexandria, VA at the Hampton Inn and Suites Alexandria Old Town Area South for a two night stay. Dinner is on your own this evening. The hotel provides free 24-hour shuttle service to Old Town Alexandria and Huntington Metro station. There are plenty of restaurants and shops to occupy your evening. (B)

Day 7 – DC Touring – White House Visitors Center – Illuminated Monuments Tour – After breakfast, meet your local guide for DC sightseeing. Your tour begins at The White House Visitors Center where you gather information on the history of our Presidents home. Then you enjoy a stroll around the building and conversation on security, the flow of government from the OEOB, the protestors in Lafayette Park and much more.

Next is a visit to Capitol Visitors Center where you begin to understand the history of the Legislatures home and flow of government from Capitol Hill to the White House. If time allows your guide will offer a walk across Capitol Hill past the Library of Congress and Supreme Court Building.

Coming off Capitol Hill, you will lunch on own in the Cafeteria at the Smithsonian Air & Space Museum. Then you free time to enjoy your choice of Smithsonian Museums.

This evening's dinner is at Tony and Joe's Seafood Place at the Georgetown Waterfront. While enjoying tempting dishes you have spectacular views of the Potomac River, Kennedy Center, Washington Monument, Roosevelt Island, and the Key Bridge.

Ending the day, enjoy an Illuminated tour past Washington's most famous Monuments. You will stop at Lincoln from where you walk to the Vietnam Wall and The Korean Memorial, then visit the WWII Memorial, Jefferson, or FDR and more if time allows. (B,D)

Day 8 – Dayton, OH – Departing Alexandria after breakfast, you travel to Dayton, OH for a night at the Hampton Inn Dayton-Vandalia. Dinner is included this evening at a conveniently located local restaurant. (B,D)

Day 9 - Depart for Home – After breakfast, you depart for home. (B)
