After leaving Louisville, you will travel to **West Virginia** where you will visit **Tamarack** which has more than 2,800 artisans from all fifty-five counties in the state and they have greeted millions of visitors, offering unique Appalachian goods. You will be given vouchers so you can sample the delectable Appalachian inspired cuisine prepared by the Tamarack chefs.

Next stop is three nights lodging at a **Virginia Beach** oceanfront hotel. You will love the 3 mile boardwalk along the beach with many vendors and restaurants. Take a stroll, ride a surrey, try a bike ride or just sit on one of the many benches and people watch. You will want to bring along a colorful shirt or dress, flip flops, beach hats when we listen to a *Beach Boys Boardwalk Bash Dinner Show*. Get in the mood with *"California Girls"* *"Surfer Girl"* or *"I Get Around"*. You can sit and listen or get up and dance.

You will tour the **Virginia Beach Military Aviation Museum**. The collection of Military aircraft is amazing and after the tour lunch will be served with a musical tribute to Frank Sinatra and then a flyover by an historic airplane. The Concert in the evening is the *"Sounds of the Supremes"*. This concert music has shown itself to be one of the most definitive and enduring contributions to American Pop music history and it will have you dancing in the aisles, swinging and swaying to the best of music.
